WILL THE CHURCH PRAY?

We are united on the Forward Movement. But the Forward Movement will succeed **only** if we are united in continuous intercession.

WILL OUR PRAYING HAVE POWER?

Yes! Provided we are at agreement (Mathew 18:19) and have sin put out of our hearts (Ps. 66:18).

WHAT IF WE DO NOT PRAY?

HOW SHALL WE PRAY?

1. INTELLIGENTLY! Study the literature and learn the needs.
2. DEFINITELY! Make a prayer list for specific persons and definite things.
3. UNCEASINGLY! "Men ought always to pray and not to faint!" Have regular and uninterrupted times for prayer and let the prayer SPIRIT prevail.
4. BELIEVINGLY! "Whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing ye shall receive."

1. That the Forward Movement Leaders may be empowered for service.
2. That God's plans may be our plans.
3. That a reviving may be experienced in all our congregations.
4. That all our young people may find their life plan.
5. That all our people may give as true stewards of God.
